

# 2006 AHAA Horse Improvement Incentive Program

To encourage Appaloosa breeders to attend the Alberta Horse Improvement program, and specifically to encourage these breeders to provide to the program, Appaloosa horses of Superior quality and with the level of training that is always in high demand in the horse market, the AHAA has created an Incentive fund to be run on a trial basis for the years 2004 to 2006.

In financial support, each year would have \$2000 added to the program with \$250 going to each of the Conformation classes and \$750 going to each of the performance classes. Monies will be given out based on the combined Judges score on a sliding scale where the horse who scores the highest will receive the largest portion of the pot.

Additional recognition will also be given to horses that score Classic or premium, these horses will have their pictures published in the AHAA newsletter, on the AHAA website and their pictures will be featured in the AHAA booth.

## Rules:

- 1) Participants must be entered in the Appaloosa portion of the Horse Improvement Program
- 2) Only ApHC registered Appaloosa horses will be eligible.
- 3) To be eligible horses must be entered in the program and pay a \$50 fee to the Appaloosa Horse Association of Alberta. Horses who do not wish to participate in the incentive program need only pay the evaluation fee to the Horse Improvement Program.
- 4) There will be 2 separate entry forms, the usual HIP entry form and a form for the incentive program – the incentive form is sent directly to the AHAA.
