## Class Specifications

### Western Pleasure

Horses to walk, jog-trot and lope both ways of the ring. Horses may be asked to hand gallop and back. Tack should be appropriate to CEF breed specifications and the age of the horse. Rider appointments as per CEF breed specifications.

### Hunter Pleasure

Horses to walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Horses may be asked to hand gallop, extend gaits and back. Tack should be appropriate to CEF breed specifications and the age of the horse. Rider appointments as per CEF breed specifications.

### Reining

To be conducted and judged in accordance with NRHA Rules. Pattern to be posted 2 hours before the class.
