ApHC rules will apply to all classes according to the 2009 official handbook.

1. **ENTRY DEADLINE – FAX BY MAY 30, 2010** – Entries faxed after MAY 30, 2010 pay a post entry fee of \$10 per horse per show/judge. (see rule #4) **EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ERRORS ON ALL ENTRY FORMS.**
  2. **CATTLE CLASS ENTRY DEADLINE – MAY 27, 2010** – Entries will not be accepted after the deadline.
  3. **POST ENTRY FEE** - \$10 additional charge per horse per show/judge. Horses already entered in the show can enter additional classes without a post entry charge. Post entries accepted minimum 3 classes prior to the class being entered.
  4. If entries are made for both days and the exhibitor wishes to change entries, they may do so by filling out individual class correction forms, indicating additions, scratches, or change of exhibitor. If these Class changes are received in the show office at least one hour prior to the class, the class(es) will be deleted and not charged. All other classes which are scratched will be charged.
  5. In cases of classes with posted order of performance, any horse missing its turn will be eliminated from that class unless otherwise arranged in advance. A working order will be drawn for all individual work classes including Halter.
  6. A \$50 NSF charge will be charged on all cheques not honored and failure to clear the debt promptly may result in suspension from the ApHC.
  7. All horses are subject to drug testing and all owners agree that by making their entry, they will allow their horses to be tested.
  8. **REGISTRATION PAPERS:** Original papers or current photocopy must be presented with all entries. Master registration form must show owner exactly as listed on the papers. Non pro and Youth exhibitors must produce registration papers showing ownership or proving approved relationship to the owner.
  9. **MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS:** Every person competing in an AHAA approved show must possess a current AHAA membership for their points to count for the AHAA year end awards. If the exhibitor wishes to enter the ApHC approved classes the must possess a current individual ApHC membership card, or ApHC membership card with Non Pro/Youth privileges, recorded solely in their name, or must complete a membership application and pay at the show, which will be submitted with the show roster. Show management must inspect this membership card or photocopy of it at any show the exhibitor has entered.
  10. **EXHIBITOR NUMBERS:** Each horse will be issued an exhibitor number at the show.
  11. **UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT:** When an exhibitor, owner and/or his representative acting on behalf of the exhibitor is guilty of unsportsmanlike conduct and/or inhumane treatment of a horse while on the show grounds, the Show management, at its sole discretion, may suspend such individual(s) from competition and a report will be forwarded to ApHC. No refund of entry fees will be made.
  12. Youth or Non Pro classes will automatically be combined if there is not a point class in 1 division. The classes that are combined will be run at the time the Youth/ Non pro classes would be scheduled
- HIGH POINT AWARDS:** In order to qualify for a high point award exhibitors must show to both judges. Points will be tabulated throughout the show. Points are awarded using the 'points per horse shown' method eg: 1<sup>st</sup> place out of 6 entries will receive 6 pts, 2<sup>nd</sup> = 5 pts, 3<sup>rd</sup> = 4 pts, 4<sup>th</sup> = 3 pts, 5<sup>th</sup> = 2 pts, 6<sup>th</sup> = 1 pt. Scale will be a sliding scale depending on number of entries in class. Ties will be decided by the participant with the most 1<sup>st</sup> place achievements.
13. Classes eligible are as follows:
    - Junior Horse (eligible classes are 36,38,42,43,44,59,66, 67, 68, 80, 83, 86)
    - Senior Horse (eligible classes are 37, 47, 60, 71, 81, 84, 87)
    - Non Pro (eligible classes are 6,12,20,26,30,32,34,39A,49,52,62, 73, 76, 82, 85, 89)
    - Novice Non Pro (eligible classes are 6,12,20,26,30,32,34,39,48,51,61, 72, 75, 88)
    - Youth (eligible classes are 13,21,29,40,50,55,64, 74, 79)
    - Novice Youth (eligible classes are 13,21,28,46,54,70, 78)
    - Walk/Trot Youth (eligible classes are 13,21,27,45,53,63, 69, 77,)
    - Cattle Horse (eligible classes are 83, 84, 86, 87, 90)
    - Halter Horse (eligible classes are 1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9,10,11,14,15,16,17,18,19, 23,)
    - All Breed (eligible classes are 101,102,103,104,105,106,107,108,109,111)
  14. \$20 Haul in/grounds fee will be applied to those horses that are not stabled at the event.
  15. **RV PARKING:** Free – limited number of plug-ins on grounds. Full service campground adjacent to Calouri Pavilion (403) 556-6981
  16. **ARENA USE:** The indoor/outdoor arena and wash rack will be available for use on Friday evening.
